England, Adams percussion Revolver, 1851, double action, 5 shot, .32, .44, .45 cal, 5" barrel



USA, Colt Mod. 1851 Navy Percussion Revolver, 1851, single action, 6 shot, .45 cal



England, Greener Over Under Percussion Howdah, 1854, 1 trigger per barrel, .577 cal



USA, Volcanic Navy Pistol, 1855, lever action, 10 shot, .41 cal Volcanic, 8" barrel, also a 8 shot, with an 6" barrel, tube mag. under the barrel



France, LeMat Pinfire Revolver, 1856-1865, single action, 9 shot .42 cal PF & 1 shot .63 cal smoothbore, (shown is a percussion conversion)



USA, Smith & Wesson Mod. 1 Revolver, 1857, single action, 7 shot, .22 cal



France, Lefauchaux Pin Fire Revolver, 1858, single action, 10 shot, 7mm PF



USA, Savage Navy Percussion Revolver, 1861, lever action, 6 shot, .36 cal, 7" barrel



USA, Remington Army Mod. 1861 Percussion Revolver, 1861, single action, 6 shot, .44 cal



USA, Pond Pocket Revolver, 1861, single action, 6 shot, .32 cal RF, 5" octagonal barrel



USA, Smith & Wesson Mod. 2 Revolver, 1861, single action, 6 shot, .32 cal RF



USA, Sharps 4 barrel Derringer, 1862, 4 shot, single action equivalent, .22 or .32 cal, barrels slide forward to load



USA, American Arms Double Barrel Derringer, 1866, 2 manually rotating barrels, one each .22 & .32 cal RF, Also both barrels in .41 cal RF



USA, Remington Double-Barrel Derringer, 1866, 2 shot, single action, .38, or .41 cal



USA, Remington Navy Rolling Block Pistol, 1867, single shot, .50 cal CF



USA, Smith & Wesson Mod 1-1/2 Revolver, 1868-1875, single action, 5 shot, .32 cal RF



England, Webley RIC Revolver, 1868, double action, 6 shot, .442 cal, 4.5" barrel



USA, Colt Mod. 1 & 2 Derringer, 1870-1890, single shot, .41 cal short RF, 2 1/2" barrel



USA, Colt mod. 1871 Revolver, 1871-1872, single action, 6 shot, .44 cal RF, 7 1/2" round barrel



USA, Colt Open Top Pocket Revolver, "Old Line", 1871-1877, single action, 7 shot, .22 cal short and long RF, 2 3/8" or 2 7/8" round barrel



USA, Marlin Standard Revolver, 1872, single action, 5 shot, .30 cal RF, Factory engraved with rosewood grips



USA, Colt Army (Peacemaker) Revolver, 1873, single action, 6 shot, .45 cal (and various other calibers), 4 3/4" barrel, also 3", 5 1/2" and 7 1/2" round barrels are standard but barrel lengths were from 2" to 16"



USA, Colt New Line Revolver, 1874-1876, single action, 5 shot, .22 and .30 short and long cal RF, 1 3/4" or 2 1/4" round barrel, the longer barrel was standard



USA, Merwin Hulbert Frontier Revolver, 1876-77, single action or double action, 6 shot, .38 or .44 cal, 6" or 7" round barrel, lanyard ring



USA, Colt Lightning Revolver, 1877-1900, double action, 6 shot, .38 caliber long and short Colt, various barrel lengths



USA, Colt Thunderer Revolver, 1877-1900, double action, 6 shot, .41 caliber long and short Colt



USA, Colt Frontier Revolver, 1878-1905, double action, 6 shot, .45 caliber, 7 1/2" barrel (other various barrel sizes)



England, Lancaster 4 Barrel Pistol, 1878, double action equiv., 4 shot, .380 or .455 cal.
Also, Lancaster 2 or 4 Barrel Howdah, 1878, double action equivalent, 4 shot .577 cal



German, Mauser Zig Zag Revolver, 1878, 6 shot, 10.6 mm



England, Webley Bulldog revolver, 1878, double action, 6 shot, .38 or .442 cal, 2.5" barrel



Portugal, Abadie Revolver, 1878, 6 shot, 9.1mm, lanyard ring



USA, Smith & Wesson Mod. 2 DA revolver, 1880, double action, 5 shot, .32 and .38 cal, 3.25" barrel



German, Reichs Revolver, 1883, double action, 6 shot, 10.6 mm, lanyard ring



England, Webley Mk.1 Revolver, 1887, double action, 6 shot, .442, .455, .476 cal, 4" barrel, lanyard ring



Italy, Bodeo revolver, 1889, single action, 6 shot, 10.4 mm



USA, Colt Navy Mod. 1889 and Army Mod. 1892 Revolver, 1889 & 1902, single or double action, .38 cal long and short Colt, .38 cal S&W, .41 cal long and short Colt, .32-20 cal, 6" barrel, & various other lengths



England, Enfield Mk.I & Mk.II Revolver, 1880-1889, double action, .476 cal Enfield, 5.75" barrel, lanyard ring



German, Borchardt Mod. 1893 Automatic, 1893, semi-auto, 8 shot, removable clip, 7.63 mm, detachable stock



USA, Chicago Firearms Palm Pistol, 1893, double action, 7 shot, disassemble to load, .32 cal extra short



Austria, Mannlicher Mod. 1894 Automatic, 1896, semi-auto, 5 shot integral Magazine, load using charger clips, 7.63 mm



USA, KOLB Baby Hammerless Revolver, 1896, double action, 6 shot, .22 cal short RF, 1.25" barrel, folding trigger, (Nickel plated, mother-or-pearl grips) Overall length is 4 ½"



German, Mauser C96 "Broomhandle" Automatic, 1896-1936, semi-auto, 10 shot integral Magazine, load using charger clips, 7.63 & 9 mm, also in 6 and 20 shot integral Magazines.



German, Bergman Mod. 1897 Automatic, 1897, semi-auto, 6 shot removable clip, 7.65 mm



England, Webley Mk.4 Revolver, 1899, double action, 6 shot, .455 cal
