This sheet makes use of the layering features available in Acrobat 6 and later. You can turn on or off various layers to customize the look of the sheet to best match your game, whether it's *d20 Modern*, *d20 Future*, *d20 Past*, or *Urban Arcana*!

Sheet "Recipes"

By enabling certain layers while disabling others, you can tweak the overall appearance of the sheet. Here are some ideas to get you started, but you can easily come up with more permutations!

d20 Modern Character Sheet, "standard" (like the book) look:

- d20 Modern HP Header
- d20 Modern HP
- d20 Modern Headers
- d20 Modern Gray Text
- d20 Modern Text Non-Form
- d20 Modern Text
- d20 Modern HP Bar
- d20 Modern Bars
- Default
- Lines Non-Form
- Master Default

For "standard" d20 Future or d20 Past sheets, just substitute the word "Future" or "Past" in each of the layers above.
